Summer Camp Rules and Instructions

These rules are intended to ensure the safety of all our campers. Please read and follow.

Arrival: We will meet all participants at the gated entrance to Cherry Creek State Park between 7:00-7:30 am on Monday, July 27th.

Departure: All participants must be picked up on Thursday, July 30th between 10:00 and no later than 11:00 am.

Behavior: Our goal is to provide a safe, positive learning environment for all our campers. Please understand that behaviors that compromise our goal cannot be tolerated. Parents will be called and asked to pick up their child if their behavior is disruptive or endangers themselves or others, and no fees will be refunded.

(This information should also be noted on the Participation Application and Liability Waiver. Especially in the case of allergic reactions, those instructions should include an emergency contact person and any immediate action that needs to be taken.

Casual Outdoor Clothes

- 1 Underwear, socks, t-shirts, shorts (4 days)
- 2 Sport/sweat pants and a jacket/hoodie (for early morning/late evening training)
- 3 Sport shoes (for outdoors training)
- 4 Flip flops
- 5 Swimming shorts/swimming suit
- 6 Bath/Beach towel
- 7 Toothbrush, toothpaste
- 8 Soap, shampoo
- 9 \$.25 (quarters) for the showers 1 quarter / 1 minute
- 10 Sunglasses
- 11 OFF Spray (for kids < 20% DDT) for the mosquitoes
- 12 Hat, Cap or Bandana!!!!
- 13 Flashlight
- 14 Sleeping bag, Pillow, Winter hat (to sleep in case of cold weather conditions)
- 15 Old Gi (karate uniform) if you have one (for water training)
- 16 Karate protective gloves and mouthpiece (if you have one)

Food/Drinks: Do not bring anything. Dojo will provide delicious meals and beverages. No drugs or alcohol of any kind is allowed on premises of the campground!
